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## Gender Distribution of Applicants

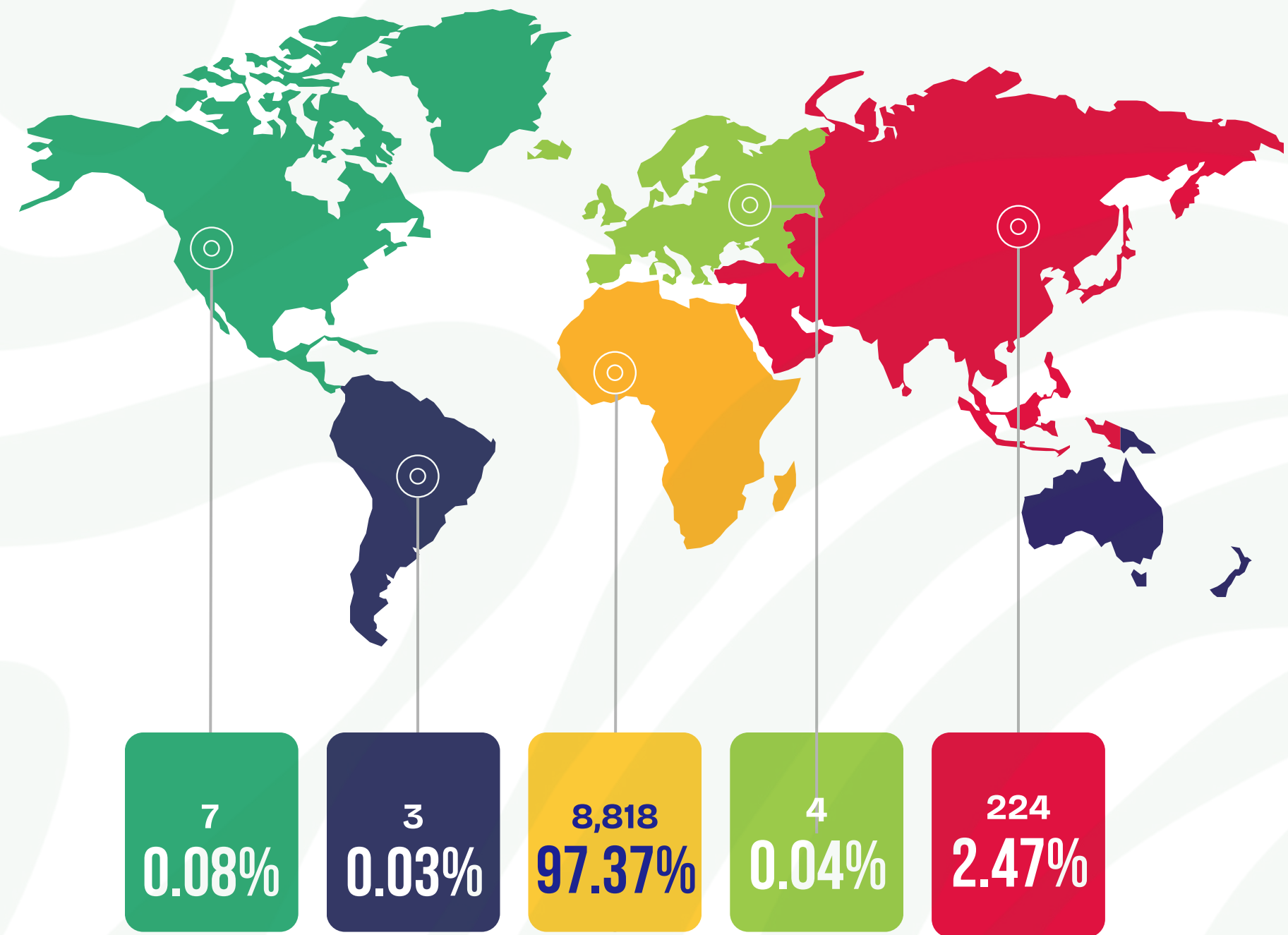

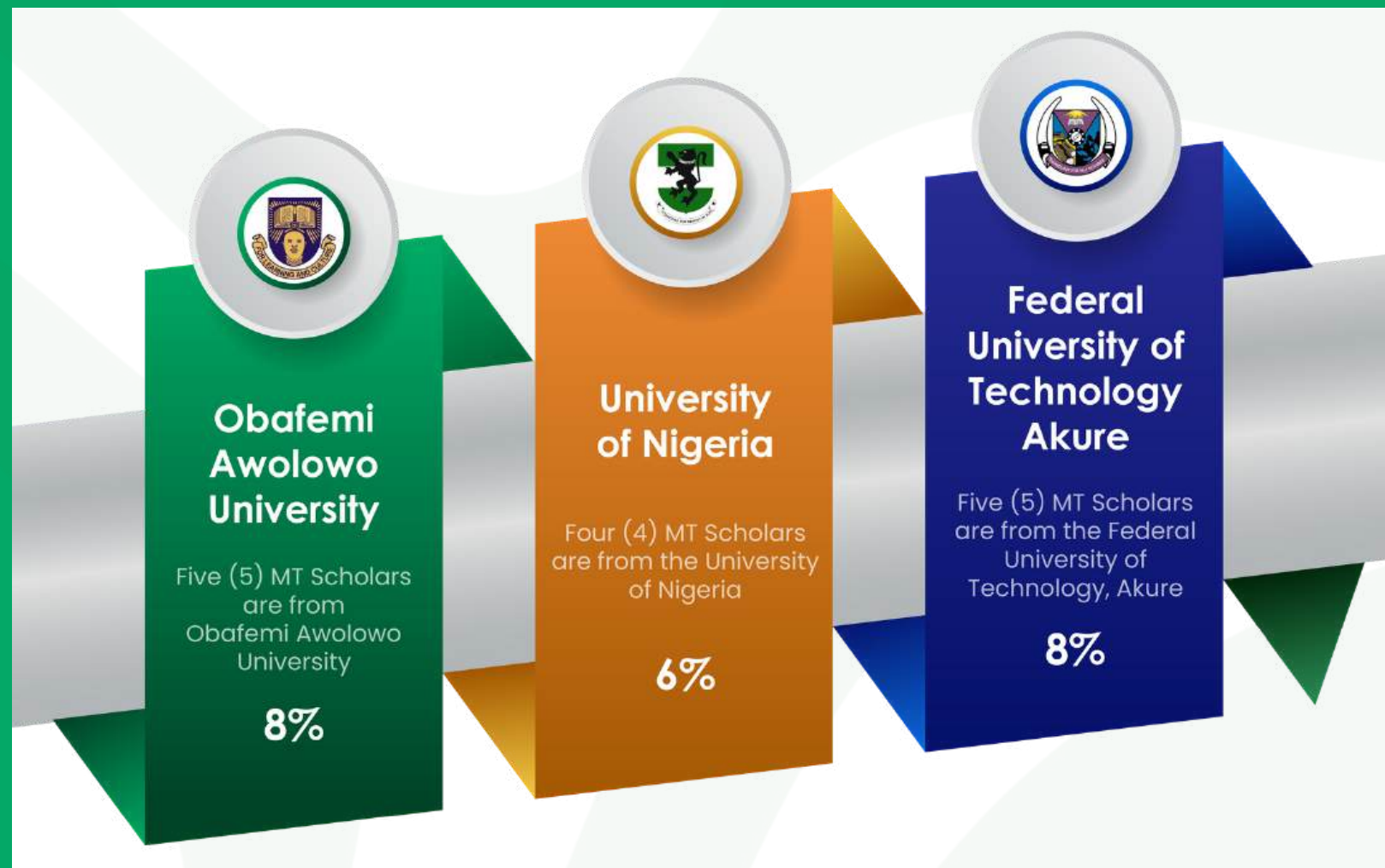

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## Distribution by Undergraduate Institution Type



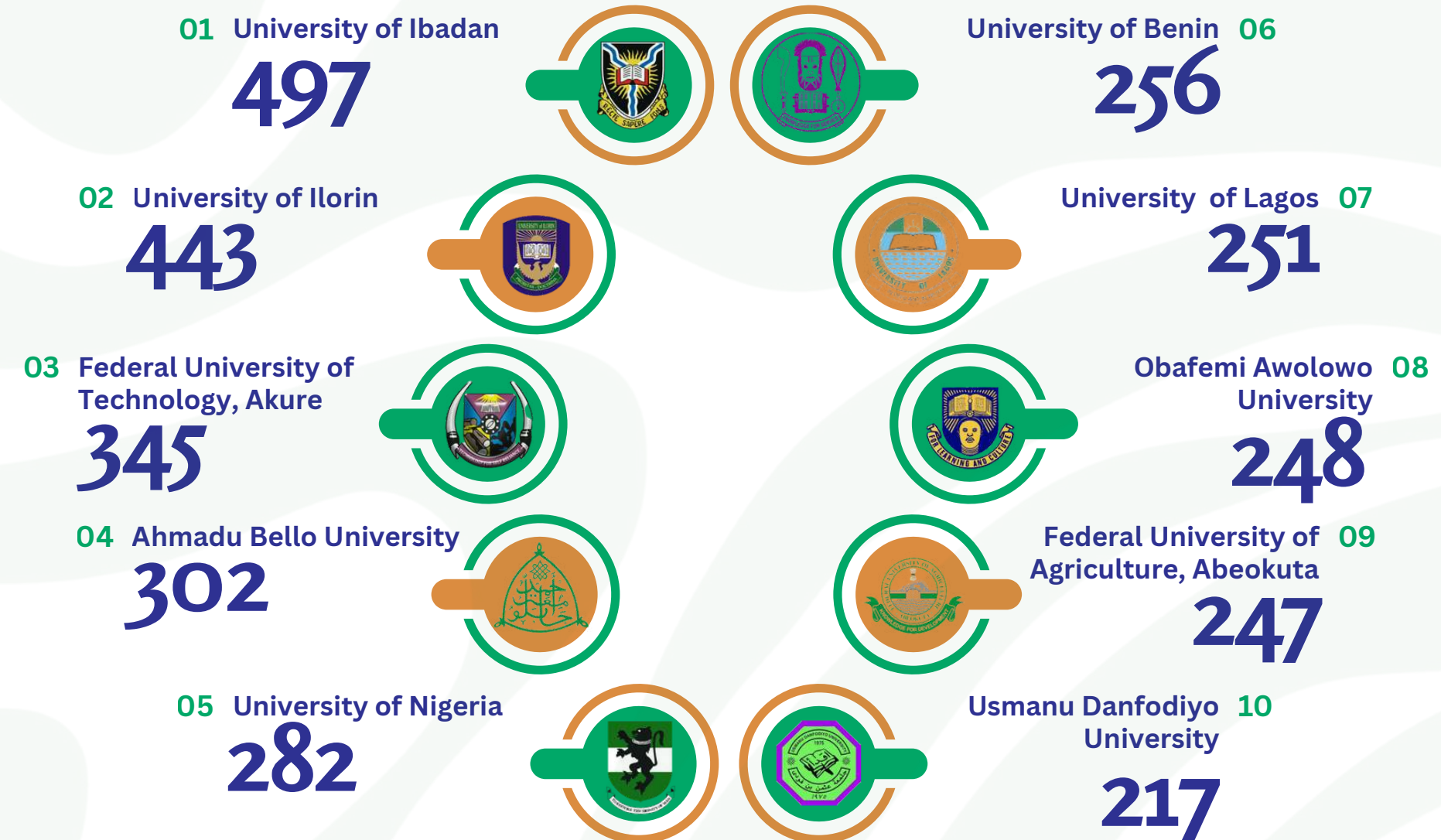

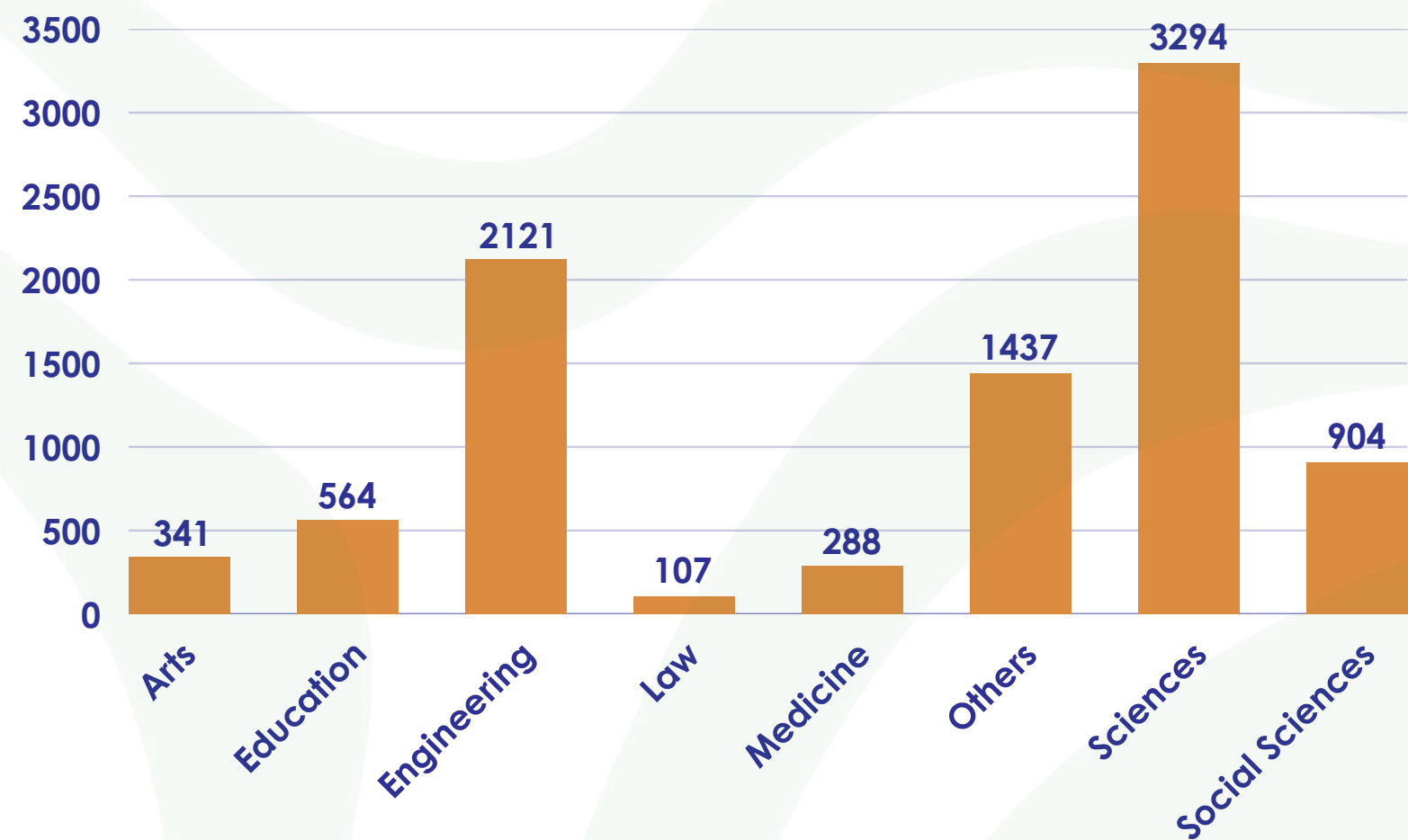
## Top 10 Universities of Applicants





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## Distribution of Applicants by Field of Study

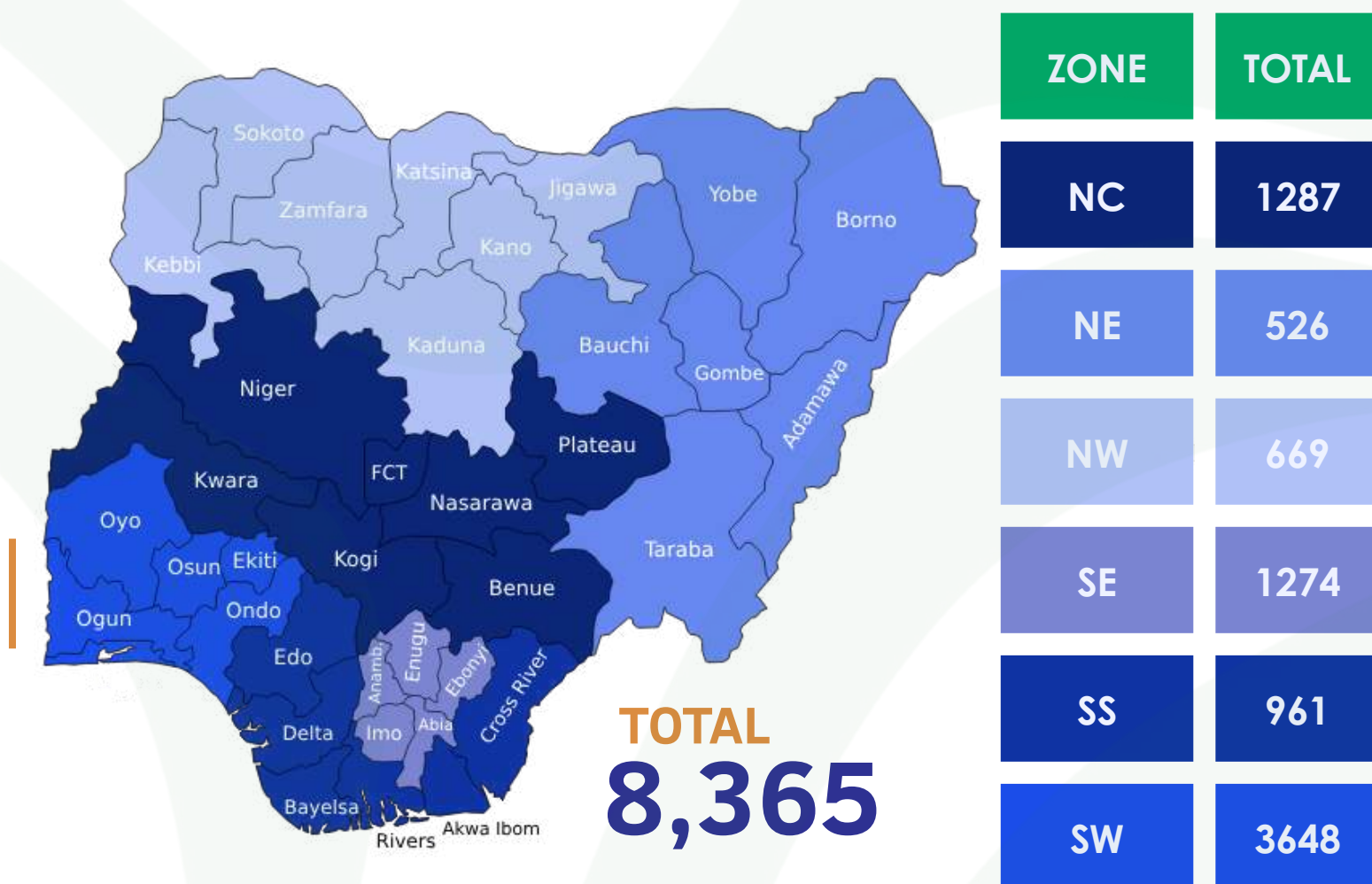


## Distribution of Applicants by Class of Degree

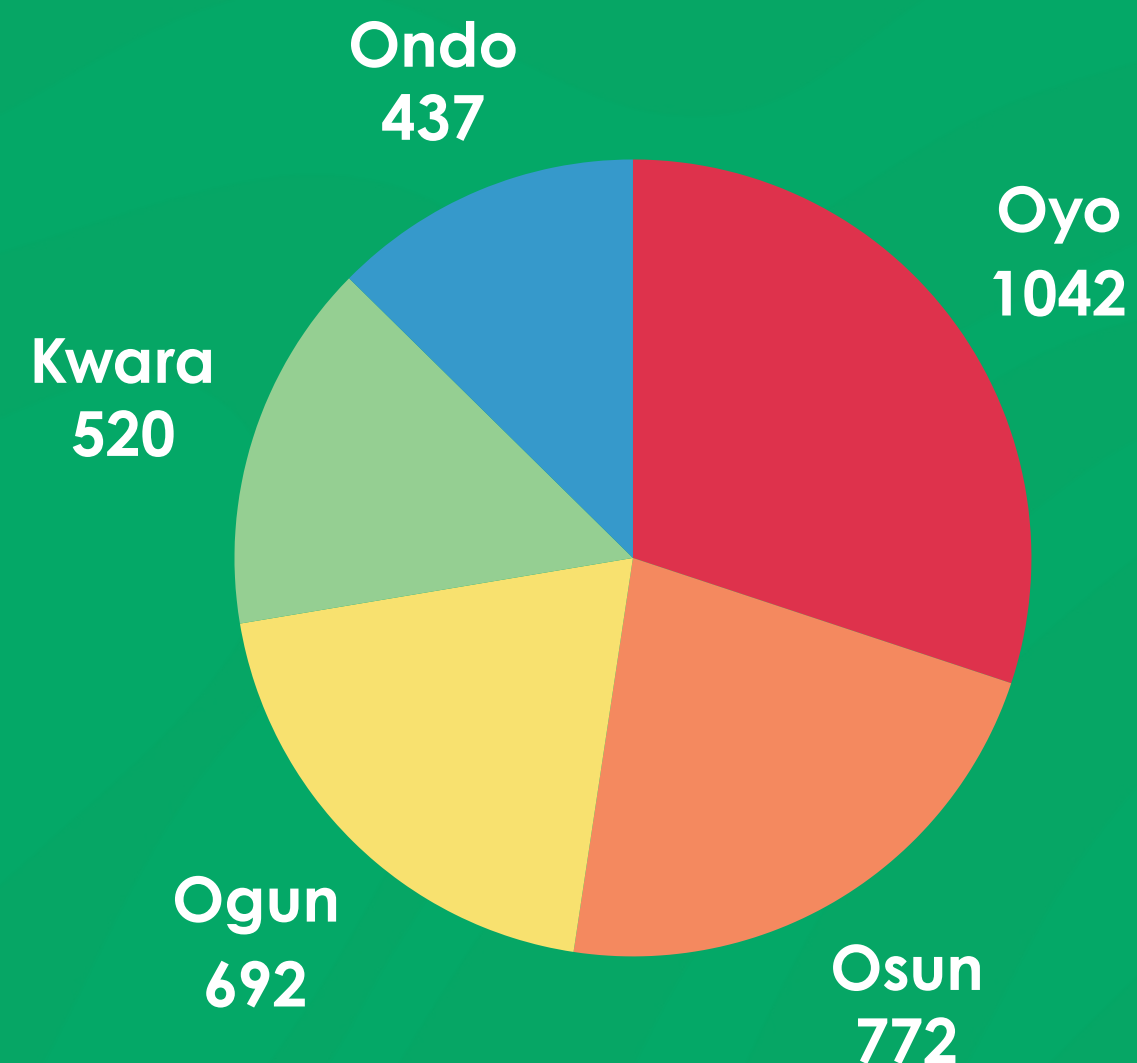




## Distribution of Applicants in Nigeria by Geopolitical Zone

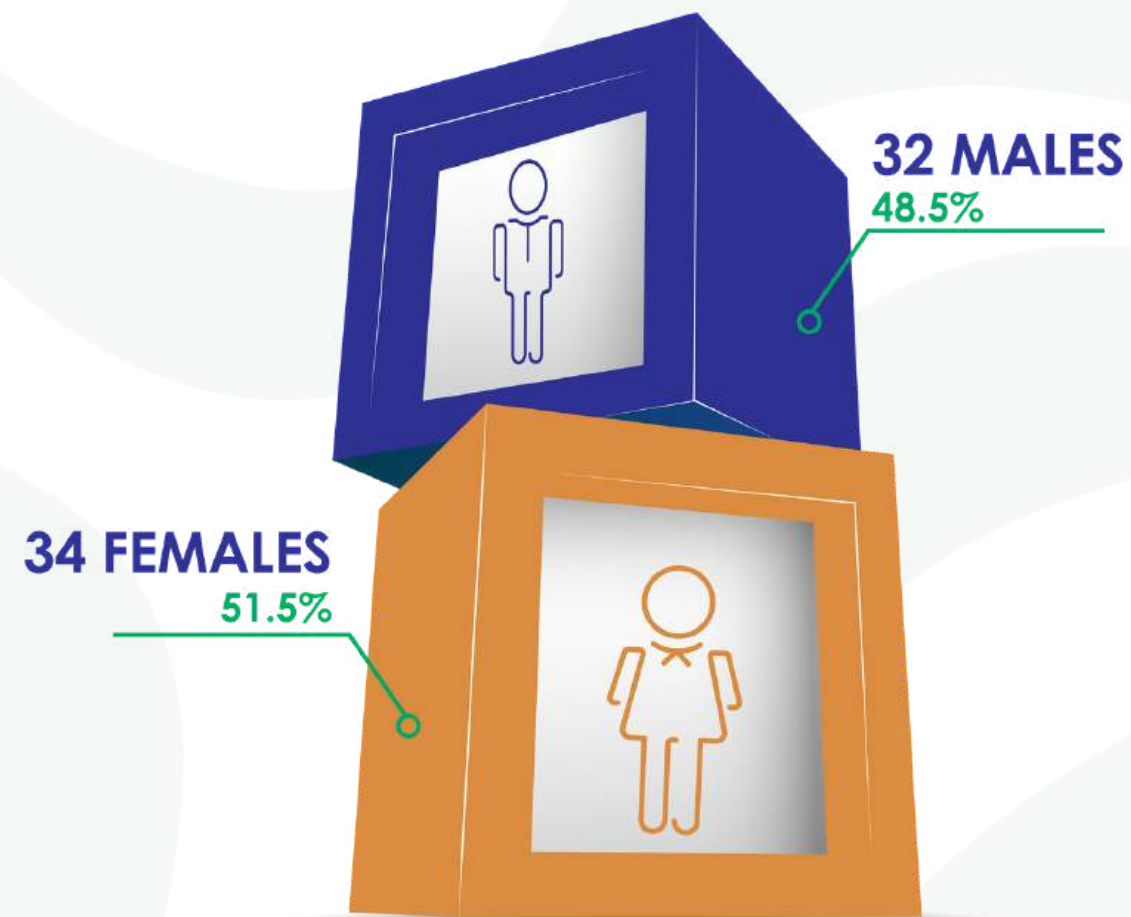

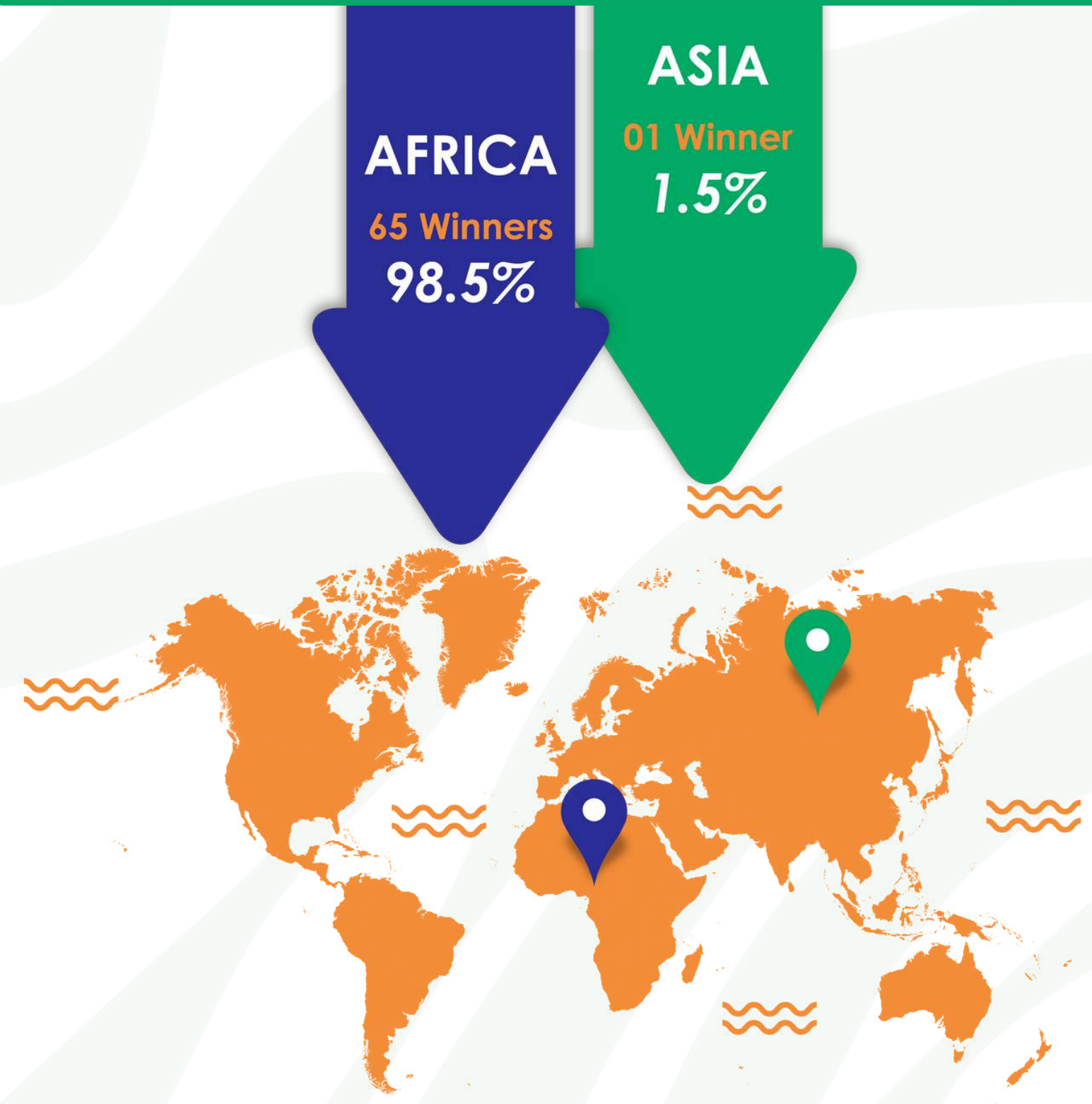


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## Gender Distribution of Scholars

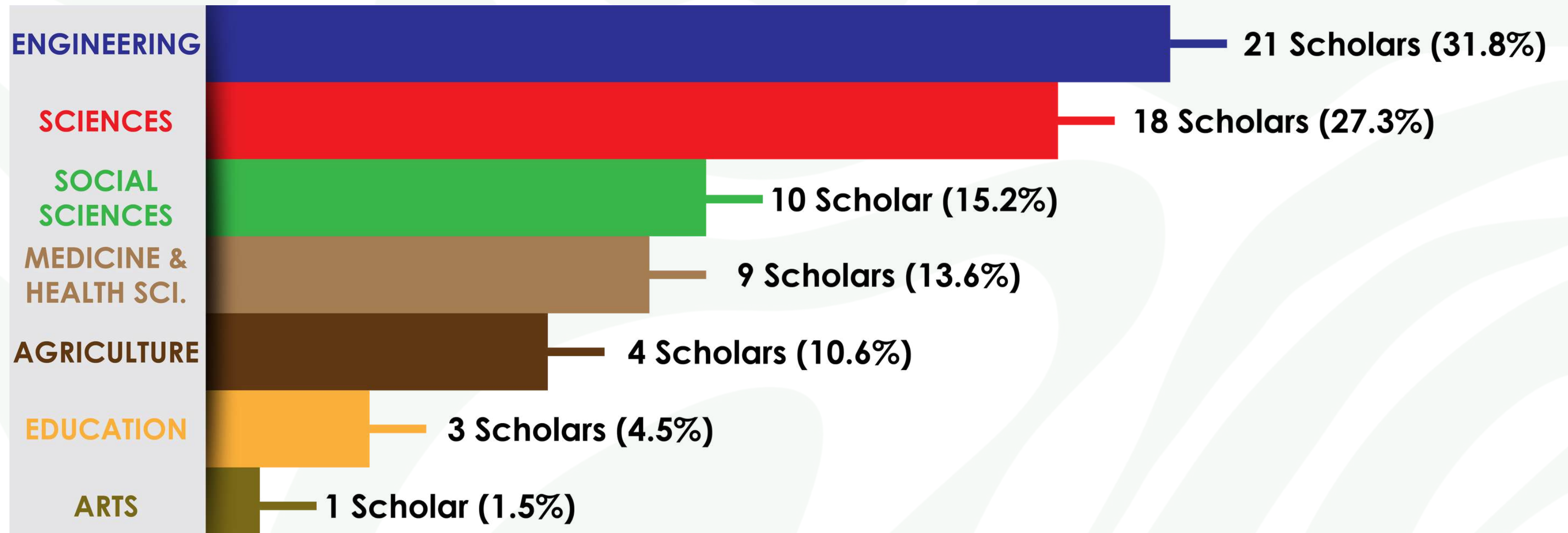
